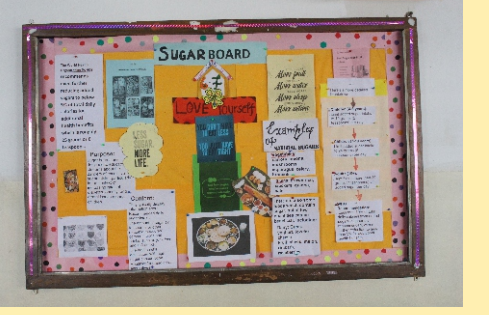
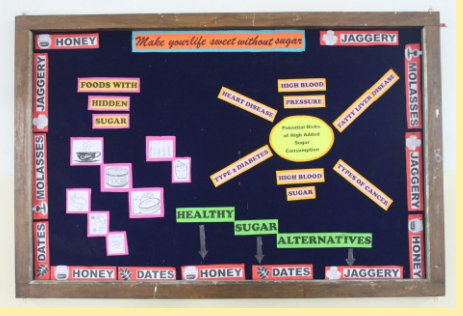

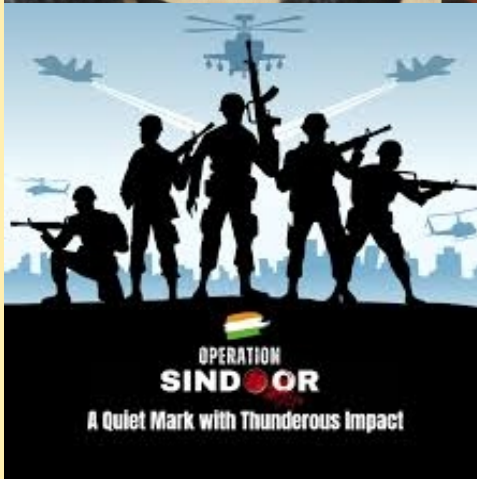
WORKSHOPS

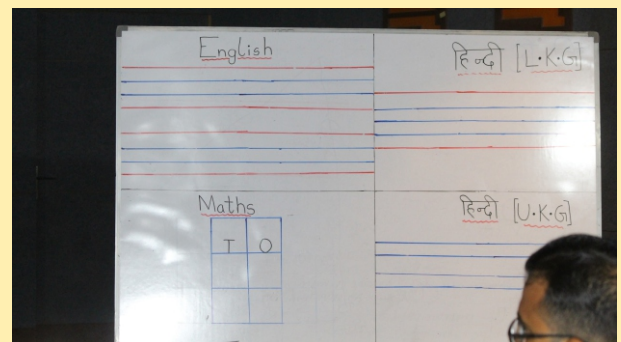
26th JULY 2025: PARENTS' ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

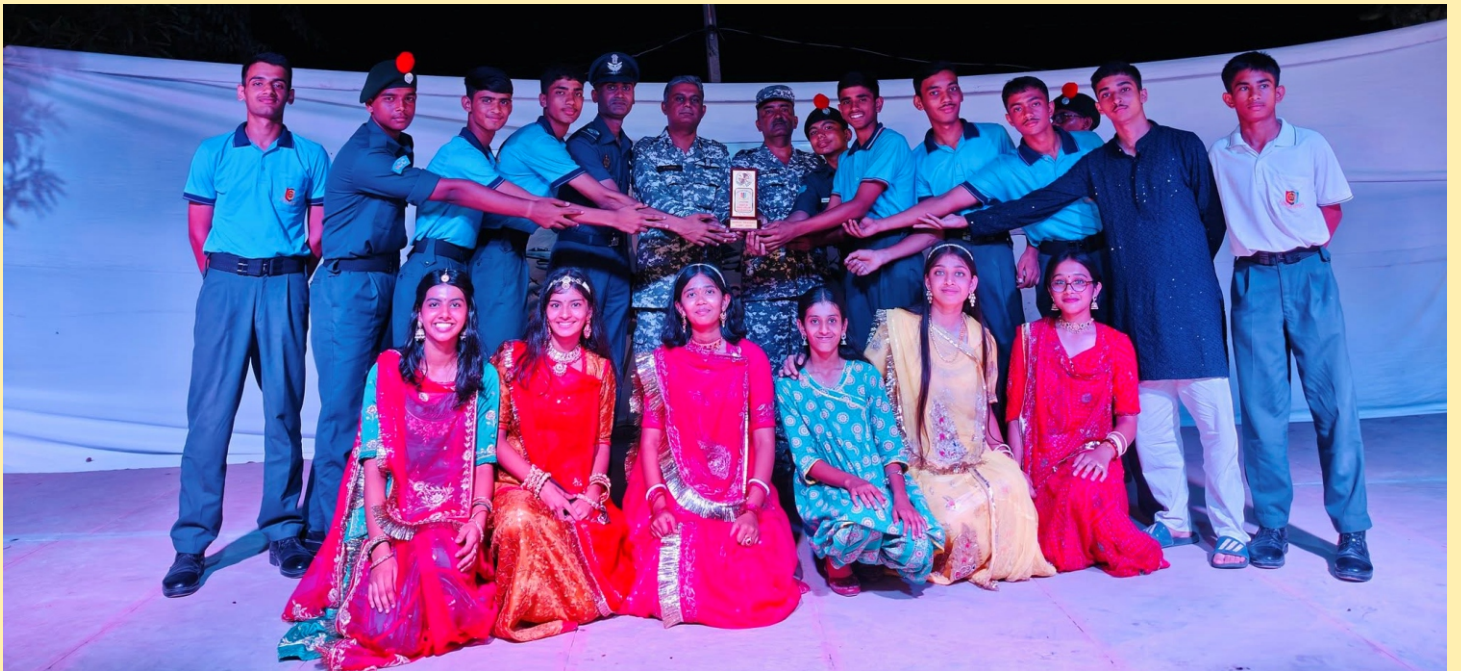

मानव की जिज्ञासु प्रवृत्ति उसे दूसरे देशों, प्राकृतिक, सामाजिक, ऐतिहासिक और धार्मिक स्थलों की यात्रा के लिए प्रेरित करती रही है। इसी जिज्ञासु प्रवृत्ति के कारण मानव अपना सुख - चैन और नियमित जीवन छोड़कर दुर्गम और बीहड़ रास्तों पर घूमता रहता है। अपने एकाकी जीवन से ऊबकर मानव यात्रा की शरण लेता है। यात्रा उसे जीवन के वास्तविक अनुभवों का आस्वादन देती है। यह यात्राएं ही तो हैं जिन्होंने आदिमानव को आज के सुसभ्य और वैज्ञानिक युग के मानव का जामा पहनाया। महान भारतीय वैज्ञानिक सी.वी. रमन को रमन प्रभाव की खोज की प्रेरणा सन 1921 में समुद्री यात्रा के दौरान मन में उठे सवाल से ही मिली थी। यात्रा का महत्व बस यात्रा के लिए ही नहीं है। एक यात्री आनंद प्राप्ति और जिज्ञासा की पूर्ति के साथ ही दैनिक जीवन की एकरसता से भी बचा रहता है। इतना ही नहीं, देश-विदेश की जानकारी भी उसे यात्रा से ही मिलती है। यात्रा से हमारा ज्ञान समृद्ध होता है पुस्तक के ज्ञान की बजाय प्रत्यक्ष ज्ञान अधिक प्रभावी होता है। यात्राओं से जहां हमें देश-विदेश के खान-पान, रहन-सहन, सभ्यता और संस्कृति की जानकारी मिलती है तो वहीं दूसरी ओर मन के कई बंधन टूटे जाते हैं और यह विश्वास भी होता है कि मानव मूल रूप से एक ही है। विश्व बंधुत्व की भावना को अद्भुत सरकार दिलाने में भी यात्रा की अपनी विशिष्ट भूमिका है यात्राओं से जहां मानव मन की आपसी दूरियां कम होती है तो वही हमारा मन भी उदार होता है।

यात्राओं और पर्यटन के महत्व को पहचान कर ही विश्व का हर एक देश अपने ऐतिहासिक स्थलों, अद्भुत भौगोलिक स्थानों, प्राकृतिक स्थलों और अजायबघरों की भव्यता और दर्शनीयता को सजा- संवार कर दुनिया के सामने सुनियोजित तरीके से पेश करते हैं। यह यात्राएं ही हैं जिससे मानव के दिलो दिमाग में अंतरराष्ट्रीयता की भावना पैदा होती है। उसकी यात्राओं के दौरान कई प्रकार की भ्रांतियों और अज्ञान का भी निवारण होता है। राष्ट्रीय और अंतरराष्ट्रीय सहयोग की भावना को बढ़ावा भी यात्राओं से ही मिलता है। जीवन की यथार्थता का अभ्यास कर काल्पनिक दुनिया से बाहर आने का अवसर भी मानव को यात्राओं से बखूबी प्राप्त होता है।

यात्राओं के कई रूप हैं। इंसान जहां अपने जीवन की एकरसता को मिटाने के लिए यात्रा करता है तो कभी वह विभिन्न प्राकृतिक, भौगोलिक और अन्य वैज्ञानिक खोजों के लिए यात्री बनता है, कभी वह अपने आवश्यक कार्यों से यात्रा पर होता है तो कभी विश्व की विविध छटाओं को निहारने और कभी ब्रह्मांड के अनसुलझे को सुलझाने हेतु प्रेरित होकर यात्रा करता है। इसी क्रम में एक विद्यार्थी के रूप में अपने आसपास के स्थलों से लेकर देश और दुनिया की सैर के जरिए पुस्तकीय ज्ञान को और आज के ज़माने में यदि कहें तो तकनीकी युग के संसाधनों के रूप में इंटरनेट आदि से प्राप्त ज्ञान को प्रत्यक्ष रूप में अपने समक्ष पाकर चाक्षुष ज्ञान के रूप में वास्तविक रसास्वादन के माध्यम से प्राप्त ज्ञान को चिरस्थायी बना पाने में सक्षम हुआ है। इस दृष्टि से विद्यार्थियों के लिए तो यात्राओं का महत्व विशेष रूप से उभर कर सामने आता है। महाकवि रवींद्रनाथ ठाकुर कहते हैं - "यात्राओं के माध्यम से जीवन का वास्तविक आनंद जो मैंने प्राप्त किया उसका सकारात्मक प्रभाव मेरे समग्र जीवन की बुनियाद के रूप में पड़ा।

यात्राओं के ज़रिए हमें अपने अनुभवों को पुष्ट करने का अवसर तो प्राप्त होता ही है इसके अलावा हमारे भीतर संघर्ष शीलता, नेतृत्व क्षमता, शारीरिक, मानसिक और बौद्धिक विकास, सौंदर्य बोध, सकारात्मकता, प्राकृतिक जुड़ाव, सहृदयता, उदारता और कृतज्ञता जैसे सद्गुणों को भी पल्लवित पुष्पित होने का मुक्त अवसर प्राप्त होता है। वैसे भी जन्म से मृत्यु तक जीवन भी तो एक यात्रा ही है जो हमें ईश्वरीय वरदान के रूप में प्राप्त हुआ है। इसीलिए शायर ने इस यायावरी, यात्रा, पर्यटन और सैर को अपने शेर में क्या खूब प्रस्तुति दी है- सैर कर दुनिया की गाफ़िल, ये जिंदगानी फिर कहां?

जिंदगानी गर रही भी तो, ये नौजवानी फिर कहां?

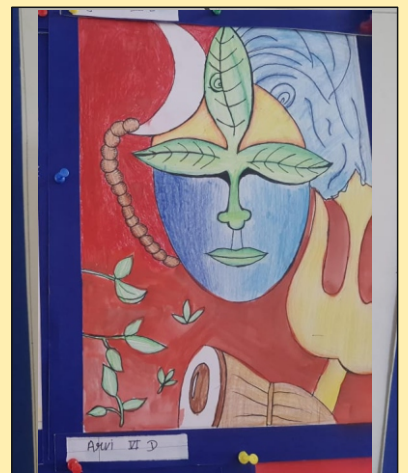
